This seminar will give an introduction to Peek, the Portable Eye Examination Kit, a revolutionary tool that uses smartphones to test eyes easily and affordably anywhere in the world. Peek tackles avoidable blindness by increasing access to high-quality eye care. It has been developed through a collaboration by the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, the University of Strathclyde and the NHS Glasgow Centre for Ophthalmic Research. It is currently in use in the field in several low-income countries.

This event will incorporate a live demonstration of Peek by Dr Mario Giardini from the Department of Biomedical Engineering, who leads the design of the Peek gadgets that see inside the eye.
